

**Resolution No. 12.3**

While approving the budget estimates for the year 2009-10, the members of the BOM observed that the provision for computer with peripherals should only be limited to those offices which had not purchased the computer or peripherals earlier. Accordingly amendment may be made in the budget for onward transmission to various offices of the PLRS.

**Resolution 12.4**

It was noted by the members of the BOM that comments from Deputy Commissioner, Rupnagar may be awaited for additional expenses for Tehsil Nangal and Anandpur Sahib and therefore, the agenda item was deferred till the next BOM meeting.

**Resolution No. 12.6**

The members of the BOM felt that expenditure to the tune of Rs. 2.67 crores which is a very large amount for providing decentralize revenue training. On a suggestion from a member that for the time being the training should continue at Jalandhar and Member Secretary, PLRS should discuss with Director-General, Mahatama Gandhi Institute of Public Administration, Sector-26, Chandigarh for providing training to the Revenue Staff falling in the districts of Rupnagar, Mohali, Patiala and Sangrur. The revenue training for the districts of Ludhiana, Nawanshahr, Hoshiarpur, Gurdaspur, Amritsar, Tarantarn, Kapurthala and Jalandhar may continue in the DLR office as large amount of funds have been expended in creation of IT infrastructure which should be properly utilized. The training for the balance districts shall be decided subsequently once the experience at the Pilot training at MGPSIPA is obtained and analyzed.

**Resolution No. 12.7**

It was decided that the proposal be sent to be MD, PIDB for taking up the construction of 9 super-A category Tehsils at the earliest.

**Resolution No. 12.8**

The progress was noted and it was felt that the UCs for digitization of the Mussavis and Data Entry work should be expedited.

The agenda item was discussed and it was felt that the office of the FCR which is continuously monitoring the progress of the integrated Land Management System Project does not have a vehicle to send teams to the districts for inspection and on the spot study. It was therefore decided that the agenda item is approved and the vehicle with the chairman of the PLRS may be placed at the disposal of the vice-chairman office for inspections and touring in the districts.
